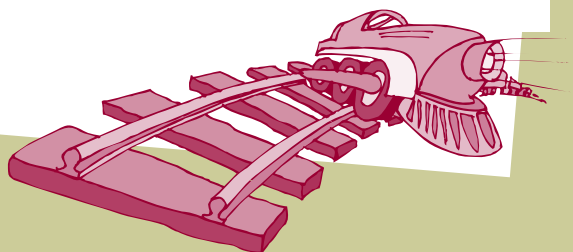

Mountain Rail Adventures

Saturday April 28th marks the Elkins area's official celebration of the ramp and its railroad history. From 10:00 am to 5:00 pm, the 4th Annual Ramps and Rail Festival in Elkins Town Square will offer a full slate of activities, including music, costumes and, of course, the pungent wild onion and trains. New to the this year's festivities is the Ramps Costume Contest, which is a chance for individuals and community groups to win a \$300 cash prize while promoting products and/or celebrating the art and bounty of ramping. The festival, sponsored by the Elkins Depot Welcome Center, the Randolph County Development Authority, the city of Elkins and the West Virginia Division of Culture and History, also features vendors serving ramp dishes and live music throughout the day on the town square stage. Among the ramp infused dishes that will be available for purchase are the Kiwanis ramp burgers, ramp-a-roni rolls, ramp shrimp wontons, ramp spring rolls, ramp barbecue sandwiches, ramp burritos, ramp corndogs and ramp Philly cheese steaks. Every vendor will also offer non-ramp dishes. Appalachian arts and crafts are featured including hand-made fossil jewelry, hand-twisted and dyed clothing, hand-knitted doggie clothes, rock candles, hand-made copper jewelry, West Virginia honey products and many more. Fair-goers will get a preview of the many offerings from vendors of the local seasonal farmers market as well as kettle corn and hand-made ice cream.

We are planning on meeting at the Crossings Mall Shopping Plaza in Elkview WV at 8:00am in Saturday, April 28th-we will have breakfast at Bob Evans for those want to join us. For those that want to car pool (**Travel arrangements are on your own**) you can leave your car at the shopping plaza or meet your ride elsewhere. We need to collect the money for the train ASAP - **we will be riding the 3:00 pm train - the cost is \$10.00 per person.** Please mail your money by April 14th, 2012 so we can insure that we all have a ride on the 3:00pm train as a group and get our reservations in. The trains fill up fast so we need to pay in advance to make sure we get to ride the train. The train is a one hour round trip to the town of Norton and back.

We will plan on having dinner at C.J. Maggie's in Elkins round 4:30pm. It's within walking distance of the train depot. The website for C.J.
