



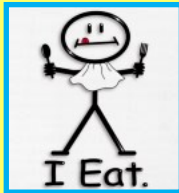

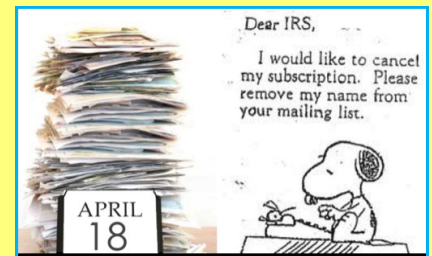
It's "that time of year" again. Dinners all over the place. Vicky has some local dinners posted on our interest site calendar, or just search the internet or this picture's site.
