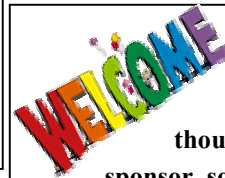

above for the area you'd like to be on.

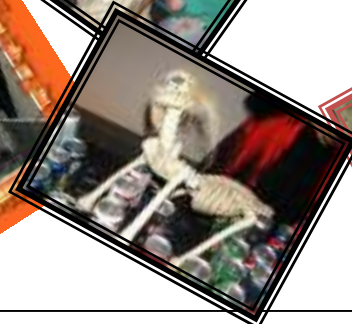
